Dear Parents and Caregivers of Cardijn College students,

As you are aware the Premier has announced a state-wide lockdown in South Australia for the next seven days.

As a result, Wednesday 21 July will be a school closure day. This time will allow our staff to prepare for the commencement of remote learning. This is a school closure day and, as such, no online learning will be provided.

The College will remain open only for care of the children of essential workers. We will have a small number of staff on site at our Noarlunga Downs campus to provide supervised care to families who require this service. If you are classified as an **essential worker** and you require care for your child during the lockdown, please email details including the child's name and year level and the nature of your essential work to [admin@cardijn.catholic.edu.au](mailto:admin@cardijn.catholic.edu.au) as soon as possible and by no later than 8pm this evening. More information will be provided to these families.

Remote learning will commence from Thursday 22 July and be provided to all students via SEQTA. Remote IT support will be available should any student encounter problems accessing the SEQTA platform. Further information will be provided to both students and families tomorrow to support the commencement of remote learning.
