

MARIAN CAMPUS ENROLMENT APPLICATION PROCESS

Our enrolment criteria

At Marian Campus, the main entry point into the College is Year 7. The following criteria are applicable for applications for this year level. To be assessed under these criteria, applications must be submitted and received by the applicable closing date. The date of application may come into effect in conjunction with these criteria when enrolment applications exceed the number of places available.

Enrolment at other year levels

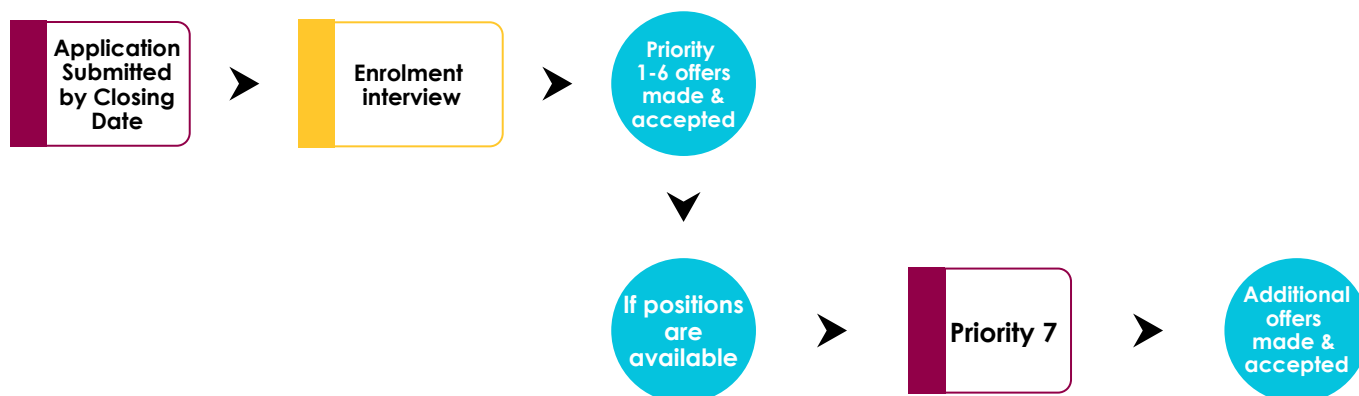
Offers for applications from families seeking enrolments in other year levels, as well as applications lodged after the application due date, will be made at the discretion of the Principal if and when positions become available.

Enrolment Priority:

1. All children who have siblings at Cardijn College.
2. Catholic Children from families who are active parishioners in a Catholic Parish.
3. Catholic children who have completed their education in one of the Noarlunga/Seaford/Willunga/Morphett Vale Parish primary schools.
4. Catholic children who have completed their education in any other school.
5. Children who have completed their education in any Catholic School.
6. Children of alumni of Cardijn College.
7. Families seeking a Catholic education for their children.

Enrolment interviews

Enrolment interviews are held for all applications received by the due date.



Enrolment Timeline

- Families have until the end of Term 1, Year 5 to submit their enrolment application.
- Enrolment interviews are conducted in Term 2, Year 5.
- Priority 1-6 offers are made by the end of Term 2.
- Priority 7 offers will be made if and when positions are available for offer.
